## **★**Application and Study term★

- Each enrollment is good for 1 study term, meaning 6 months.
- Study terms begin in April, July, October, and January every year.
- If the number of applicants exceeds our capacity, participants will be chosen by lottery.
- In case you would like to continue to study after finishing 1 term, please reapply.
- If you can't enroll in the class you requested, you are eligible to apply for the class in next term.
- The maximum duration of study in CCIEA Class is 4 terms. If you have studied for 4 terms, you are not eligible to apply again.

## **★Requirement for students**

- 1. Regular attendance is necessary; it is very important to maintain a regular schedule to master a foreign language.
- 2. Be sure to inform the CCIEA office of your absence <u>in advance</u> if you plan to be absent from a class. If you are unable to attend a class on the very day of the lesson, please inform the CCIEA office (TEL: 03-3297-0251/Email: bunkoku@chuo-ci.jp). If you have been absent without any notice for several consecutive lesson days, your name may be removed from the enrollment list.
- Please understand that there will NOT be a specific volunteer teacher assigned to each student; there will be different volunteer teachers to work with you. The Japanese language volunteer teacher is <u>not your personal teacher</u>.
- 4. The number of students for each teacher will vary according to the number of students who attend on the day.
- 5. Be sure to bring your name card, textbook(s), notebooks, pencils and erasers with you.
- 6. In the classroom, political, religious and commercial activities are prohibited.
