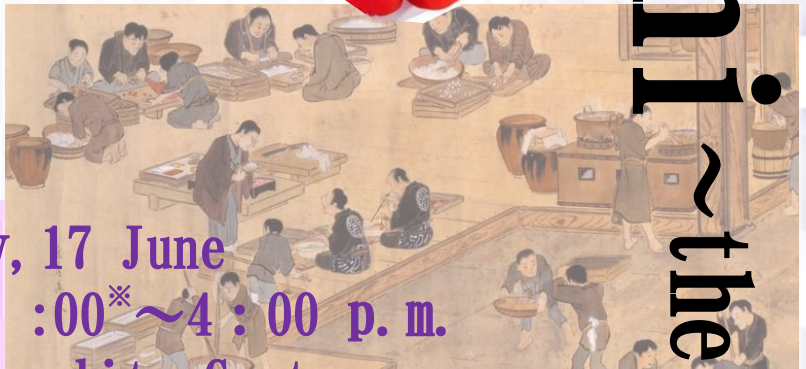


CCIEA International Exchange Salon
