Earthquakes! They strike unexpectedly, without warning.

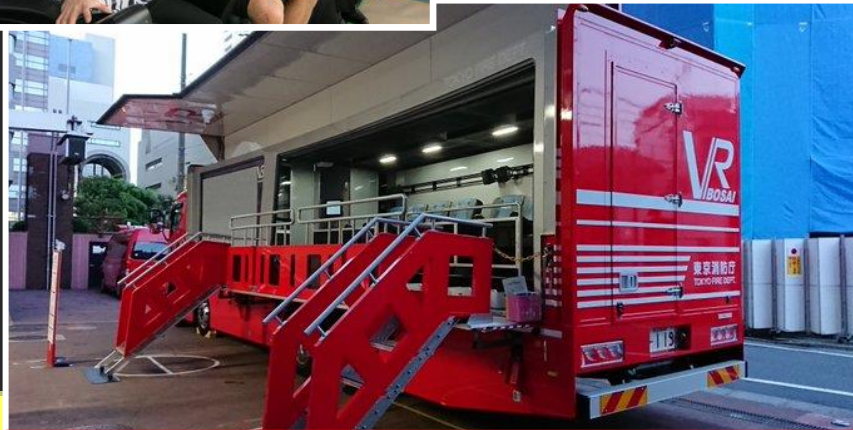
